

Assignments:

Assignments are for you to show your interpretation of the subject topic. There is no right or wrong! The topic is there to encourage us to think about what types of images we are taking and push us out of comfort zones to take new types of images and thus try new things.

With this in mind we can then show and explain our learning on the club night when showing the images, have a chat about techniques and others can learn or suggest ideas from their view point.

We all have different views about our own or others images so remember friendly peer suggestions and questions/debate. With this we can all help each other learn and grow.

Club Competitions:

The Club holds X5 Internal Competitions per year:

X2 DPI (Summer DPI & Winter DPI) and X2 Print (Spring Print & Autumn Print).

These Competitions have topics which are broad for all members to be able to access and push themselves and their photography skills. Topics for each of these competitions can be found in the main programme table on the dates of each competition. In the Competitions you can submit up to X4 images per member. Scores out of 20, constructive critique and suggestions will be given by an external Judge. Judging is a great way to learn what other people might look for or want from images. It is their opinion and not everyone agrees with the Judge but looking at images (be it our own or other members images) from someone else's angle can help us progress with our own photography journey.

This year the club committee have decided to make the Image of the Year DPI Competition a separate evening from the winter DPI and place it at the start of the new calendar year. So the 2025 Competition will be held in the first few weeks of 2026 so we have a full year of Images to work from.

Image of the Year Competition:

The Image of the Year Competition will be held at the start of the calendar year, so the 2025 Image of the Year Competition will be held in the first few weeks of 2026. In this Competition it is an open topic where you can submit up to X4 images per member. We encourage you to put in your very best images from 2025 even if they have been used in past Competitions. Scores out of 20, constructive critique and suggestions will be given by an external Judge with the winning image being named the Club's 'Image of the Year'. In addition any new members will be also be in the running for the 'Newcomer Image of the Year'. This will all be included within the same Competition on the evening.
